## DAY 7: EDINBURGH CITY TOUR AND GLENKINCHIE DISTILLERY

Wake up to high levels of excitement as today you would be taken to Glenkinchie Distillery, the name might suggest, in a glen of the Kinchie Burn near the village of Pencaitland. It is situated about 15 miles from Edinburgh. The distillery is set in farmland. After seeing the Exhibition area and having a taste of a single malt, you will proceed to Edinburgh for a guided tour. On this tour, you would be seeing the Edinburgh Castle; the famous castle was built on the remains of an old volcano and is said to be haunted. Edinburgh has been the capital of Scotland since the 15th Century and stands proudly on seven hills creating the dramatic skyline of this lively cosmopolitan city. You can compare Edinburgh's Old Town to the elegant Georgian New Town with its three main streets and a square at either end. You will also see Castle rock. where you can hear the tales about the hangings that took place in the Grass market and the attempts to capture Edinburgh Castle as you marvel at the impenetrable Castle Rock.

Later, return to Glasgow for dinner and comfortable overnight stay.

## DAY 8: DEPARTURE

After breakfast and check-out from the hotel, you would be heading to station for the train experience till London. Coach will pick you from London train station and drop you to the Airport to board return flight in evening. You also have an option to take flight at additional cost.
